My Brother,

Since the inception of The Most Worshipful Grand Lodge of Free & Accepted Masons of the State of Hawaii almost 30 years ago, there has been a great desire to have a building where we can conduct the business of the Grand Lodge and a place where we can meet as members of the Fraternity.


As my project for the year, I have chosen to help raise monies for the Building Fund. To achieve my goal of raising this money, I want you to understand that the total membership in this jurisdiction is 1700 members. If every member in this jurisdiction participates and makes a donation of \$100 - which is about \$8.33 a month - we will have raised \$170,000 in one year.

Although it may be impossible to get 100% participation, it's possible that we can raise this amount if there are other members who will generously give a higher amount. If we continue this in four years we will have raised almost \$680,000. This amount will not be able to acquire a parcel lot, but at least we will have the money to invest and grow. I know it may be difficult to donate a specific amount, instead I ask you to donate from the heart. In return, I pledge that no donation will be unrecognized.

If the Grand Lodge of Hawaii building materializes you can proudly say that you are a part of it and be proud to utilize the building.

I can personally assure you all that any money donation will solely belong to the building of the temple fund and not to the Grand Lodge operating fund and all subject to audit by any of the members other than the auditing committee.
